

## **Beginning Sewing with Ann Hall**

First class is January 21st and will continue each Saturday thru February 18th. Classes start at 12:45pm and end at 3:45pm. Class Fee: \$150.00. Students will keep a binder of each technique taught for their future reference. Supply/materials list will be available at registration.

In the 1st class students will learn to properly measure for pattern size, proper tools of the trade, fabric fibers/weaves, & pattern layouts. 2nd & 3rd classes will cover seams used in the industry and when to use them. (industrial machines are not necessary) There is a \$15 materials kit payable to instructor for these two classes. In the 4th & 5th classes students will make a basic pajama top and bottom using the industrial techniques. No more "homemade" looking garments.

## **Learn Flat Pattermaking.with Ann Hall**

Class Fee \$180

Class starts at 12:45 and ends at 3:45pm, beginning 2/25 thru 3/31

Learn how to achieve any design of garment with a basic 5 piece pattern.

Class #1 will include dart manipulation and proper pattermaking rules as students make their own quarter-scale patterns of 9 designs. 2nd class students will apply principles to achieve 9 more complex bodices. Class #3 will learn about neckline design and complete 12 quarter-scale patterns. Class #4 instructs on 8 sleeve designs. Class #5 learn skirt techniques. Class #6 Learn pant design which will conclude the basics of flat
